After achieving the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care, you may choose to undertake the Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. You may be able to Credit Transfer up to 13 units towards your Diploma Qualification. CAECE also offers articulation into the Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood) through partner universities on completion of your Diploma qualification.

Entry requirements

To be eligible for a school-based traineeship, you must be:

-  15 years of age or over at the start of your traineeship;
-  Interested in undertaking a Certificate III which has been endorsed by the school principal or equivalent;
-  An Australian citizen, foreign national with permanent residency status, or a New Zealand passport holder resident in Australia for at least six months; and
-  Able to attend on-the-job training at least 50 days per year (375 hours)
